Happiest People in the World is back again and set for February (more dancing animals on stage hey?). And I'm sure there's more


that

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"THE OFFICIAL THUNDERDOME APOLOGY"



Saturday 30th September 1995

The Promoters, Organisers, and Sponsors of THUNDERDOME The Party would like to inform all ticket and membership holders of the facts and truth behind the unfortunate mayhem on the long weekend! Firstly Technoise touring, Rave Olympix 2000 and Hardcore United are very disappointed with the outcome of this event, but most importantly the way all our supporters and ticket holders were treated on the night by the police, the club security, the Telegraph Mirror, rival promoters and dodgy car park ravers trying to rob and harrass our members!

We declare the following to be the truth, the whole truth and nothing but the truth, so help us God! OK, here we go...

THUNDERDOME The Party had a choice of 3 venues! Venue 1: A NSW University Entertainment Centre/Hall. Venue 2: A warehouse in Botany/Alexandria Area. Venue 3: A choice of 2 nightclubs with a 24 hour license that could cater to all ages and capacity.

Venue 1 was our first and only choice to cater for such an event until we were notified that this hall had a 3am license days prior to the event. We wre then told we could hold our event in this hall from 9pm - 3am and then move into the hall next door from 3am - 8am, which then got changed to no we could not use option 2 and we could use a private function room approximately 1 km off University Campus ie. University Hall 9pm-3am / Private Club 3am-9am.

Venue 2 was our back up venue initially in the Botany/Alexandria area of approximately 6000 sq meters including off road carparking 2 x large arenas and no neighbours to trouble, but due to South Sydneys council disapproval/banning dance parties in this area we did not want to be closed down completely!

Venue 3 was a choice of 2 inner city nightclubs that had a 24 hour license so we could run from 10pm10am secondly so we could allow all ages to be present and it was inner city for ease to travel! Thirdly it could cater
for over 1000 people and not have any sound problems. Our final choice was Saloon Tavern. We initially approached
management to use the carpark under the Saloon but due to Council Approval this was impossible as past parties had
upset neighbours in this area with the carpark use!

We were advised capacity for this venue was legally 1350 persons so on Saturday 30th we advised all ticket outlets at approximately 2pm to stop all ticket sales as is was a "Sold Out Event"! The Telegraph Mirror quoted we had sold over 3000 tickets with 2000 ticket holders being stranded outside which was a load of crap and even the clubs security spread vicious rumours about 3000 ticket sales just because our tickets were numbered from 1000 - 4000! We had admitted 2/3 of our ticket holders with 1/3 being stranded outside the venue with approximately 1500 car park ravers and gangster homies going bezerk on Parramatta Road playing chicken with the traffic!

The ticket scalper was not employed by our promotion/production team and took it upon himself to buy and sell tickets from ticket holders in que in which he sold at an inflated price!

The police were initially called to keep Parramatta Road clear for traffic as the club security kept everyone including our ticket holders on the footpath with no room to walk or passby which caused even more confusion! A rival promoter was Insane enough to make bogus calls to police and thus extra police were called in and thus extra crowd control police including the Dog Squad and other squads were moved in to disperse the crowd totally! The club was told to close its doors so no one could get in or out for approximately 1 1/2 hours in which tear gas was used on persons outside the venue to get rid of them quickly. If anyone was hurt or injured please contact us care of JRA so we can issue these extreme measures taken by police to local council and police authorities and claim against the club!

Finally the promoters feel that you the ticket holders were subject to major problems on the night and we are very sorry and apologise for the inconvienience and have refunded 99% of unhappy ticket holders! We know that the 1000 persons inside had a "Thunder Experience" but were also shaken by the outside experience! We the production team had time and desire to plan another Thunderdome party before their trip back to Holland to make up for Saturday 30th but everyone was eager for a refund and not to show their support!


